Suceava is a 100,000 inhabitant town, located 450 km North of Bucharest and is part of the historical province Bucovina famous for its monasteries and beautiful nature. Some of the medieval painted monasteries of northern Moldavia were included on the list of the world patrimony UNESCO.


Suceava is also known as a former capital of Moldavia principality.

The "Ştefan cel Mare" International Airport in Suceava is located at 12 km from the centre of the town (pick-up of the participants organized by us) and both national and international flights are operated. There are direct flights to Madrid, Milano, Bologna, Roma and London but the airport has connections with all main airports in Europe via Bucharest.

By train, Bucharest - Suceava (Burdujeni railway station) travel lasts for 7 hours.

By car, Vienna – Suceava, via Oradea, represents approximately 16-18 hours drive.
